## Implementation of the share buyback programme

As part of the implementation of its share buyback programme, VINCI signed a share purchase agreement with an investment services provider on 3 January 2023.

According to the agreement, valid from January 4<sup>th</sup> until March 29<sup>th</sup> 2023 at the latest, VINCI is mandating the investment services provider to purchase VINCI shares on its behalf within the limit of €250 million. The purchase price cannot exceed the maximum price set by the VINCI Ordinary and Extraordinary Shareholders' Meeting of 12 April 2022.
