EUROVIA, VINCI's roadworks subsidiary, has just signed two contracts in the United States worth a combined total of 141 million Euros

Hubbard et Blythe, VINCI's two roadworks subsidiaries in the United States have just signed two contracts with a combined value of 141 million Euros:

- Blythe has just finalised an 83 million Euro road contract with the state of South Carolina involving widening and reinforcement of 9kms of I-385 starting in the centre of Greenville. Apart from pavement construction, the project includes building five interchanges and a 25,000 sq. metre supporting wall. The ITS (Intelligent Traffic Services) system, supplying real time traffic information, will be used to attenuate the inconvenience caused by the works.
- Hubbard has just concluded a 58 million Euro design and build contract in Orlando, Florida, for the redevelopment of 23kms of the I-4 Interstate, a section that also includes crossing the city of Orlando itself. The widening and pavement repair operations should take two and half years to complete.

Eurovia, VINCI's roadworks subsidiary, posted sales of 430 million Euros in 2000 in the United States, a figure expected to rise substantially in 2001.

Eurovia's total sales in 2000 were 5,316 million Euros.

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
