Jean-Yves Le Brouster, CEO of VINCI Energies since June 2005, has been appointed Chairman and CEO.

A graduate of the National Engineering School in Brest, Jean-Yves le Brouster has spent his entire career in the company that is known today as VINCI Energies. After joining the company as Branch Manager in Boulogne-sur-Mer and Amiens in 1978, he was promoted Regional Manager for Nord-Picardie-Champagne-Ardennes in 1985 and appointed Deputy CEO of GTIE in 1992, which became VINCI Energies in 2003. In 1996, he was appointed Chairman and CEO of Fournié Grosaud in Toulouse before joining Santerne, where he was Chairman and CEO until 2002, when he was appointed Chief Operating Officer of VINCI Energies.

Number one in France and a leading player in Europe in Energy and Information technologies, VINCI Energies generated net sales of €3.3 billion in 2004, of which nearly 30% was outside France. VINCI Energies employs 27,000 people through a network of 700 companies in more than 20 countries.
